We are pleased to announce that the Borges Center website (www.borges.pitt.edu) has undergone numerous changes in the last few months. We completed the Finder's Guide with information about what specific works are the sources of the many thousands of references. The Criticism section has been greatly expanded, and the Timeline now contains an updated bio-bibliography, the most complete to date for Borges's works.
